STUDENT PARKING RULES

1. No student will be permitted to drive a car to school without written application from a parent or guardian. The completed application does not guarantee parking privileges for the student. All student vehicles parked on school grounds must have a current year parking permit displayed at all times. Any student not displaying a permit may lose their parking privileges.
2. Students may lose their driving privilege for violation of either Code of Conduct or other school rules.
3. Any student operating his/her car recklessly on school grounds will face serious repercussions and may lose his/her driving and parking privileges on school grounds for an indefinite period. Students are expected to exercise good driving habits and be courteous to school bus right-of-way. Any student that poses a threat to the safety of themselves, other students or who damages school property will not be permitted to have his/her vehicle on school grounds.
- 4. THERE WILL BE NO SHARING OF PARKING PERMITS.**
5. Please note it is your responsibility to get to school on time. The attendance office will not excuse students who miss classes due to flat tire, engine trouble, car will not start, train held me up, or other car related excuses.
6. Any student habitually tardy to school or class and/or truant from school or class may lose the privilege of driving on school grounds.
7. Students are permitted to park in the student parking area only. All students must park in the designated area and space provided.
8. All vehicles driven on school property must be legally registered. An improperly registered vehicle brought to the attention of the administration will be reported to the legal authorities.
9. The replacement cost for parking tags is \$10.00.
10. Students with repeated violation of the OFHS code of conduct may face revocation of driving privileges.
- 11. STUDENT CARS PARKED ON SCHOOL PREMISES ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH FOR CONTROLLED AND OTHER INAPPROPRIATE MATERIALS. APPLYING TO DRIVE AND PARK ON SCHOOL PREMISES CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE THAT THERE IS NO EXPECTATION OF PRIVACY FOR MATERIALS STORED IN THE CAR WHILE ON SCHOOL PREMISES.**
