1. What does the high school schedule look like for next year?

**The newly renovated cafeteria space will allow us to serve students more efficiently and reduce the number of lunch periods from the current six down to three. The new schedule for 2018-2019 features three lunch periods occurring during periods 4, 5 & 6.*

2. When do students need to report to school if they are not enrolled in an Early Bird class?

All students need to be present and in their 1st period class by 8:10 a.m. each school day. Attendance will be taken for all students in their 1st period class.

3. When does the school day end?

The school day ends at 2:46 p.m. for all OFHS students.

4. Will the new schedule change the bus transportation schedule?

No. The morning and afternoon school bus routes for the high school will remain the same due to the district's overall transportation schedule. Students currently in grades 9-11 who rode the bus this year can expect pick-up and drop-off times very similar to those they had this year. All students who will be utilizing bus transportation to and from the high school next year will receive a confirmation postcard as usual ahead of the start of school.

Students who take the school bus in the morning can use the time prior to the start of 1st period at 8:10 a.m. for a study hall. Reminder: we will have a totally redesigned space for students to eat breakfast, study, or work on projects before the official start of school at 8:10 a.m. Breakfast service will be available from 6:50 a.m. - 8:10 a.m.

Students who take the school bus in the afternoon can expect shorter wait times for their afternoon bus home.

5. The new schedule only has 8 periods, are we losing class time?

No. We simply combined the numbering system to clearly reflect 8 total periods.

6. When does the new schedule take effect?

The schedule will be in place for the 2018-2019 school year. The first day for students is Thursday, September 6th. Reminder: the 2018-2019 school year for Olmsted Falls City Schools begins later than normal this year due to the expansion and renovation project.

Please note that the first day for OFHS students for Ombudsman and Polaris is Monday, August 27th. Transfer buses will be running to transport students from OFHS to Ombudsman and Polaris, and back to OFHS.
