## Visitors

Visitors must enter the building using the main entrance only. Please be prepared to show your Drivers
License. You will need to ring the office by pressing the button located on the building to the left of the first set of doors. Once the office has spoken with you, you will be buzzed through the first set of doors, and enter the office through the single door to your left. All other doors will be locked.

## School Fees

Intermediate School fees for the 2015-2016 school year for 4th \& 5th Grade are $\$ 65.00$ per student. Payment can be made by check (payable to OFIS with the student's full name entered on the memo section), cash, or online (Visa/Master Card) by going to the District Website and clicking on the EZPAY logo. Partial Payments are also accepted on EZPAY.

## Attendance

If your child will be absent or late to school please call the attendance line prior to 8:00 a.m. at 427-6511. If you are calling after 8:00 a.m. please call the main office at 427-6500. Dr. excuses are required in order for a tardy or absence to be excused.
Homework may be requested if the student is out more than 1 day and may be picked up after $2: 30 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. in the front lobby (between the double doors) located on the table to the right. If an absence is not reported by 9:00 a.m. you will receive a call from our automated system to verify the absence.
Please send a note to school with your child if you need to pick them up early or if they normally ride the bus and you need to pick them up at the end of the day. For the safety of our students, the person picking up the student must come into the office to pick the child up and sign them out. This must be done even if you pick them up every day.
