When: Saturday, November 14, 2015

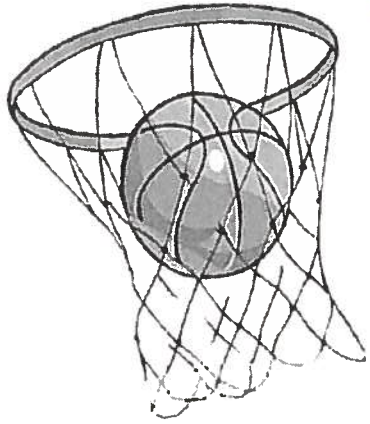
Time: 9 am till 12 Noon

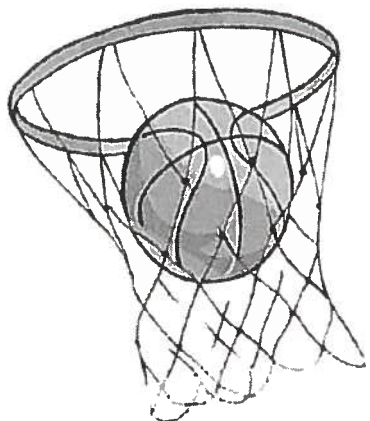
