

Transcript of Automated Phone Message Sent To All District Parents 10/22/09 Re: Confirmed H1N1 Case at Middle School

Message Transcript:

This is Kim Petrina in the Communications Office at Olmsted Falls Schools with an important District health alert for all parents.

As many of you are already aware, the District has been experiencing higher than normal absentee rates this week due to various illnesses. We are calling to let you know that today a parent of a Middle School student has reported a confirmed case of the H1N1 virus involving her child. Based upon the increased number of students absent across the District, we can assume that it is likely that other students may have unconfirmed cases of this virus as well as various other strains of flu.
