



Impact of Levy Failure on Transportation Services

Failure of November 3rd Levy will result in the following effective January 1, 2010:

- Reduction of Busing Services to State Minimums (2 Mile Cut-Offs)
- Elimination of ALL Alternate Transportation Requests
- Delay in tax receipts until 2011, thereby increasing millage amount for 2010 levy request
