Is Academic Team for you?

Do you like to travel? Meet new people? Compete against other students? Show others how much you know?

Then, Academic Team just might be the place for you!

What do we do?

We compete against other schools in various formats in Academic Competitions. The faster you come up with the answers, the more points you can score for your team.

Where do we compete?

We travel to different schools/colleges across the State of Ohio and to other states as well. Last year, we traveled to West Virginia, Georgia, and Illinois in addition to various schools/colleges in Ohio.

When and how do we practice?

We practice after school one or two days a week for about 2 hours. We practice using question sets from previous tournaments and one of our buzzer systems. The sooner you buzz in, the sooner you get to answer!

So, it's like Jeopardy?

Kind of, but not really. We use a lockout buzzer system like Jeopardy and we answer questions like Jeopardy, but the format is different and the questions are usually longer.

So, it's like Academic Challenge on TV?

Kind of, but not really. We compete on Academic Challenge, that's true, but the tournaments that we compete in are a different format than the TV show.

How do I get a chance to see what it's like before I actually decide if I want to try this?

We are having a camp this summer (August 1-5) at Olmsted Falls Intermediate School. At the camp, you will get the chance to experience practice sessions, mock tournaments, and short classes to teach you some of the things that will come up repeatedly in competitions. What if I decide after the camp that it's not for me?

No problem, it's your choice! We just want you to be able to make an informed decision as to whether or not you would like to be involved!
