A survey of 2,000 American parents with children between eight and 14 reveals that 83 percent of those parents would have liked to learn more about finances growing up. ### NOTHING I CAN DO...A TOTAL **ECLIPSE OF THE SUN**

By the time you see this, you will have certainly already read too many stories about the upcoming solar eclipse. I've seen a mix of excitement, hype, over-reaction and even a "who cares?" attitude in the stories I have read. This column will contain very little scientific information or even much of an opinion about the eclipse, as I am neither an astronomer or pro/anti-eclipse. This is what I know, per the National Weather Service: "A total solar eclipse happens when the Moon passes between the Sun and Earth, completely blocking the face of the sun. The sky will darken as if it were dawn or dusk. This April 8th, a total solar eclipse will cross North America...portions of Ohio and Northwest Pennsylvania will be in "totality" meaning the moon will completely block the visible surface of the sun. Totality will last for just under 4 minutes in Cleveland!"

To recap: the eclipse is coming. It will be dark for nearly 4 minutes. This means we will have four minutes to do absolutely nothing but wait for it to end. We may want to spend a minute looking at it with our protective eyewear. But then what? As busy parents, how often are we presented with the opportunity to do absolutely nothing for even one minute and not feel guilty about it?

There will be no school that day, due to the eclipse deciding to show up during dismissal time. Your kids might be home, but for those four minutes, you have my permission to sneak in a quick power nap. Or hide in a closet somewhere and sip your coffee in peace. You could try to read a few pages of that book that's been on your nightstand for two years, or run to the pantry to eat all the good snacks you can chew in four minutes. No one will notice because they'll all be eclipse-watching. Yay, space!

While you may have to work, no one will expect you to accomplish anything in that four minutes. Productivity will surely plummet for the brief period of time. As everyone else pauses to look up, could you put your head down on your desk for a few minutes and "rest your eyes"? Could you use your work-owned device to watch a few funny cat videos or hit "buy" on your Amazon cart? Could you microwave something stinky in the breakroom without getting nabbed? Who will notice or care? There's a major celestial event going on that hasn't happened in Ohio since 1806! (I snuck in another fact for you so that this wasn't a complete waste of your time!)

Whether you choose to go "all-in" on the eclipse or not is certainly up to you. But I think that this is a great time to remind ourselves that it is ok for our world to stop for a few minutes. With our 24/7 attachment to technology, our phones, social media, work emails and group texts, we are rarely permitted to "turn off" anything, let alone our brains. A few moments of absolute nothingness might be really good for us. Don't believe me? Check out this article! So get ready for April 8th. Get your eclipse glasses (or not) and prepare to do nothing- not a darn thing- for four minutes. 
