# How is Falls-Lenox Primary School organized?

### What time does school start and end?

The school day is from 8:00-2:35.

 If you are bringing your child to school, morning drop off is at the south door (by KidsFirst) no earlier than 7:35. After 7: 55 a.m., all visitors and students must enter and sign in at the main entrance.

## What are the dismissal procedures?

- Bus riders getting picked up—If your child usually rides the bus and is getting picked up from school, your child must have a handwritten note and will be dismissed with car riders through the south door (by Kids First).
- Temporary Changes in transportation must be in a written note by the parent. Phone calls, faxes, and e-mails will be not accepted.
- Car riders—If your child is a regular car rider, pick up will be from the kids first/south hallway.
   Car rider forms are available in the main office.

# What do I need to know about my child riding the bus?

- An email from the transportation department with your child's bus number and stop location will be sent the second week of August.
- Children are to only ride the bus they have been assigned to and from school.
- Busses pick up and drop off in the front of the building.
- Vehicles are not permitted in the front of the building between 7:15-8:15 am and 2:15-3:15 pm.
- Please encourage your child to ride the school bus—especially the first week of school.

## What is the cost of breakfast and lunch?
