

### **How is Falls-Lenox Primary School organized?**

- Approximately 700 students in grades 1-3 attend Falls-Lenox.
- Our school is organized into three learning communities: The South Community, the East Community, and the West Community. Each community consists of several first, second, and third grade classrooms.

### **What is the grade reporting system?**

- Falls-Lenox is on a trimester grading period, therefore your child will receive a report card three times a year.
- The report cards are standards based, and the marking system is S- secure, D-developing, or B-beginning.

### **What time does school start and end?**

The school day is from 8:00-2:35.

- If you are bringing your child to school, morning drop off is at the south door (by KidsFirst) no earlier than 7:35. After 7:55 a.m., all visitors and students must enter and sign in at the main entrance.

### **What are the dismissal procedures?**

- Bus riders getting picked up—If your child usually rides the bus and is getting picked up from school, your child must have a handwritten note and will be dismissed with car riders through the south door (by Kids First).
- Temporary Changes in transportation must be in a written note by the parent. **Phone calls, faxes, and e-mails will be not accepted.**
- Car riders—If your child is a regular car rider, pick up will be from the kids first/south hallway. Car rider forms are available in the main office.

### **What do I need to know about my child riding the bus?**

- An email from the transportation department with your child's bus number and stop location will be sent the second week of August.
- Children are to only ride the bus they have been assigned to and from school.
- Busses pick up and drop off in the front of the building.
- Vehicles are not permitted in the front of the building between 7:15-8:15 am and 2:15-3:15 pm.
- Please encourage your child to ride the school bus—especially the first week of school.

### **What does a school day look like?**

### **What is the cost of breakfast and lunch?**

- Free meals for all students are set to expire on June 30th, 2022 (for those who are income-eligible, free and reduced-priced meals will still be available). However, Congress is making a late push to keep meals free for all students into the 2022-2023 school year. More updates will be provided throughout the summer once a decision is made.
- Snacks may be purchased with cash or check at school. To use a credit card, you may call 1-866-693-9729 to access EZPay. EZPay takes up to 48 hours to be credited.
