**When:** August - December; usually full-group on Mondays from 2:30-3:15 and speaking parts (chosen by audition) on Tuesdays from 2:30-3:15.

**Description:** 5th grade students learn songs and dialogue for a musical performance. Children also have the opportunity to audition for solos and speaking parts as well as sign up for dance parts in order to feature their many talents. Students perform their show for the school during the day and once for invited guests at night.

**Fee:** No fee

**Grade:** 4th and 5th
