Tinkercad is an easy, browser-based 3D design and modeling tool for all. Tinkercad allows users to imagine anything and then design it in minutes.



- ★ Which season do you like best? SUMMER!!!



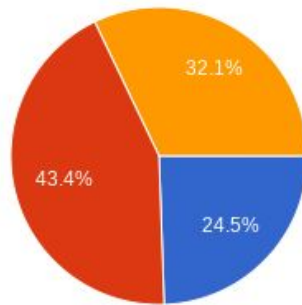
GOT SUMMER PLANS?

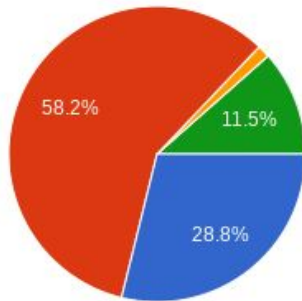

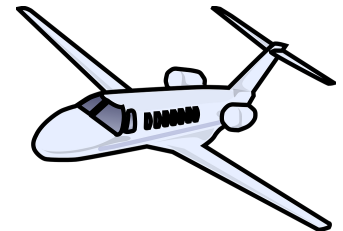

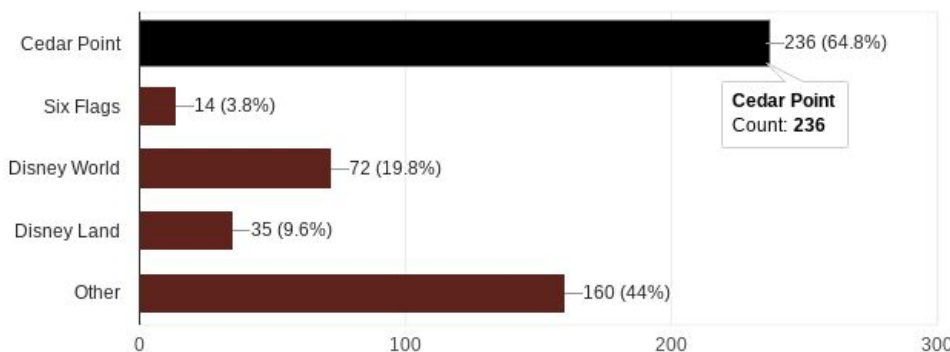

3. If you could have any job, what would it be? "Um, it would be currently what I'm doing now, (teaching) I love to help kids learn and manage their day." she told me.

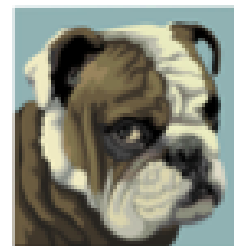
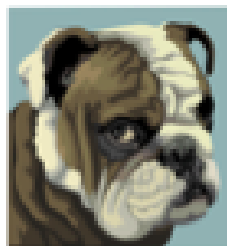
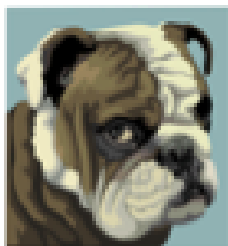

8. Do you like your job? "Yes, I love to watch the kids grow, and it makes me very proud to be part of it." she joyfully said.

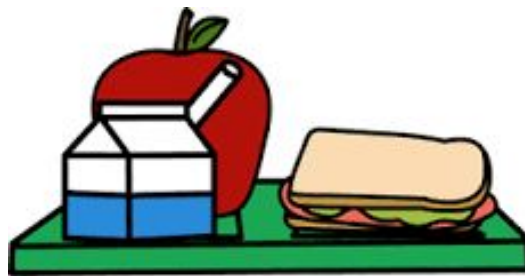
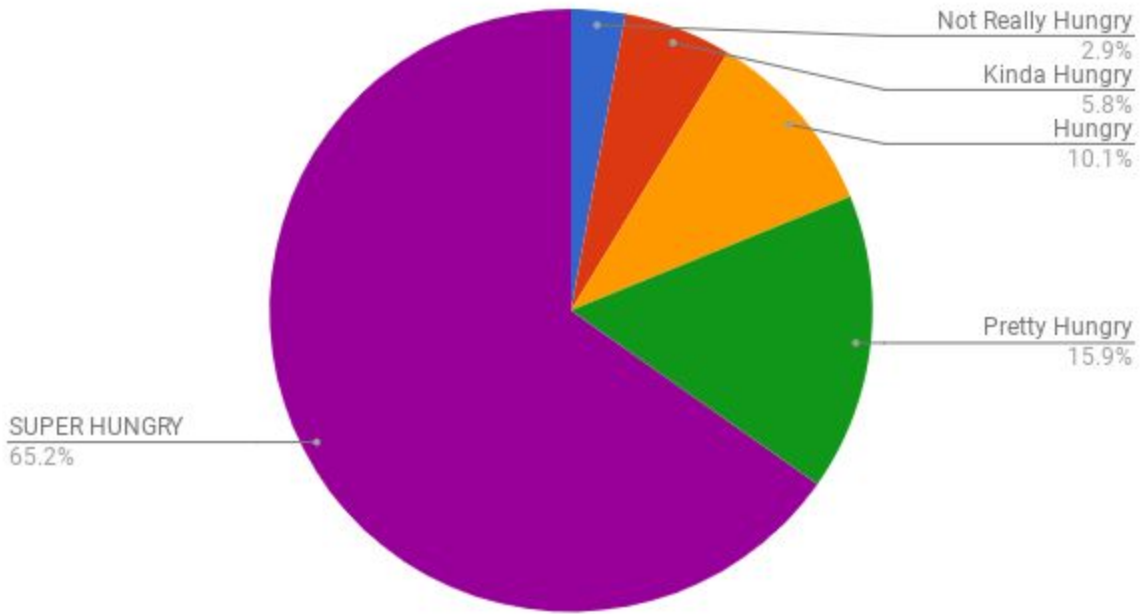


HOW HUNGRY ARE YOU BEFORE LUNCH?

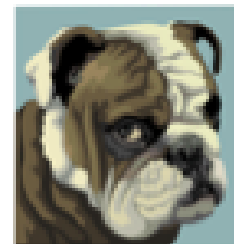
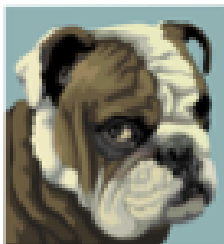
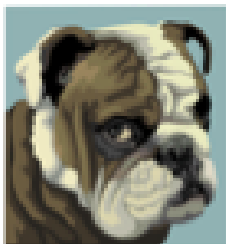
